TIMETABLE

All projects must be fully completed within the past 3 years, except in the Landscape & Gardens category, which is up to 7 years.

Closing Date for Entries

Friday 28th March 2025

All submissions must be received by this date by email with the following:

- A maximum of 6 before and 6 after photographs.
- Plans, restricted to a copy of the planning application and drawings as applicable.
- A detailed Location Map and POSTCODE of the project.

The criteria include the project's suitability for purpose, the best use of the site, the quality of workmanship and suitability of materials used.

Judging Dates and Information

Wednesday 14th and Thursday 15th May 2025

All submissions are judged by a team usually comprising a Sussex Heritage Trust Trustee, a professional in the appropriate field and a 'lay person' to ensure a balanced view. All are volunteers and receive no remuneration.

Judging can only take place on the stated dates.

Winners of Awards receive a hand-crafted slate plaque, which is to be attached to the winning project. There may also be Highly Commended projects in any given category. There can be multiple Award winners and Highly Commended projects in any category. The Building Crafts, the Young Apprentice of the Year Award and the Sussex Heritage Person of the Year Award are presented to individuals rather than projects. A Special Award is presented in the following categories, which can be entered at no extra fee when submitting a project: The Eco Award and The South Downs Award.

All parties involved in the winning and highly commended projects receive certificates. Awards are announced at the ceremony and presented by the President of the Sussex Heritage Trust, The Rt Hon Lord Egremont DL.
